### Jewish Divorce Talk Episode One – Get Refusal Talk

**Agunah (plural – Agunot):** a Jewish woman who is separated and/or legally divorced from her husband but is unable to obtain a Jewish divorce from him.

**Beth Din:** Court of Jewish Law in the U.S., it serves as a forum for family law and personal statuses.

**Get:** A document that seals a Jewish divorce, typically given from husband to wife.

**Get refusal:** Process by which a member of a couple, typically the man, does not release their spouse from marriage.

**Halachic prenup:** A legal agreement created before marriage, which will facilitate the dissolution of their marriage in the event of a divorce.

**Shabbos:** The Sabbath.

**Shabbos table:** A table arranged with ritual items for the Sabbath.

**Shomer Shabbat:** Someone who follows the rules and prohibitions of the Sabbath.
