Frum: Jewish religious devotion, contrasted by secular or engage in non-Orthodox practices.

Hagim: The celebration of holidays.

Halakha: The collective body of Jewish religious laws.

Hasidic: A subgroup of the Jewish religion.

Negiah: The concept that Jewish law prohibits or restricts sensual physical contact with a member of the opposite sex unless they are married.

Pikuach nefesh: The principal in Jewish religious law that the preservation of human life overrides any other religious rule.

Rebbe: A personal mentor and teacher.

Rebbeim: Collective group of Rabbis.

Shabbat table: The table around which the sabbath rituals and meal take place.

Tzniut: A group of Jewish religious laws pertaining to conduct; the character traits of modesty and discretion.
