### Jewish Divorce Talk Episode Three – Intimacy Talk

**Baruch Hashem:** Literally, “Blessed be God,” used to express gratitude.

**Chosson:** A groom.

**Chosson teacher:** A pre-marriage teacher for a groom, who shares the Jewish laws of marriage and intimacy.

**Frum:** Jewish religious devotion, contrasted by secular or engage in non-Orthodox practices.

**Halakhah:** The collective body of Jewish religious laws. (Plural, **halakhas**)

**Kallah:** A bride.

**Kallah teacher:** A pre-marriage teacher for a bride, who shares the Jewish laws of marriage and intimacy.

**Kibbutz:** A communal settlement in Israel.

**Neve Yerushalayim:** A college for Jewish women; the oldest and largest in the world.

**Rav:** Honorific title for teacher or personal spiritual guide.

**Rebbeim:** Collective group of Rabbis.

**Schmutz:** Dirt, filth, or a similar unpleasant substance

**Shabbat:** The Jewish Day of Rest, which runs from sunset on Friday to sunset on Saturday.

**Yeshiva:** An Orthodox Jewish college or seminary.
