Cameron has represented Olympic and Paralympic athletes in internal investigations, negotiations and hearings, including matters related to eligibility, anti-doping and team selection. He is a part of the of the [Team USA Ombuds Athlete Legal Aid Program](#), which helps athletes without sufficient financial means to address concerns before the sport-related tribunals. In this role, he had the honor of spending time on-site in Paris during the 2024 Summer Olympic Games and was available through the Paralympic Games to advise and provide counsel on urgent athlete legal issues.

In 2023, he was a member of a litigation team that secured a \$4.1 million settlement of race discrimination and retaliation claims for group of Black football players at a Division I institution.
